

Al and consciousness



Pro:

- Conversation with AI can look like symbolic communication
- We expect from our collaboration partners that they have consciousness → interests, values, relflecting about themselves and their social embeddedness, ...

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- We can inspect them, exercising oversight and control, there is an emergency switch-off-button
- Most of AI instances can be connected to each other to share data and algorithms – and thus appear as one unit instead of a set of individuals.




Proposal



We can design interaction with AI by instructing AI to play a role where it temporally pretends to have consciousness. Interaction then includes persuasion, potentially acting against an own will of AI etc.

Hence, if necessary, we can always switch into a mode of control, experimental exploration, intervention.
